As Historians we will be looking at the Victorian Era.

Key Knowledge and Skills:

COMPUTING

Spreadsheets

Key Knowledge and Skills:

Key Knowledge and Skills:

We will be inspired by William Morris' designs to make a tile in order to print our own wallpaper, using a repeating pattern.



ENGLISH Writing

As Writers, we will be focusing on the text of 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs', a wolves non-fiction text and a poem called 'A recipe to make a wolf'.

We will be focusing on the skills of simple contractions, possessive apostrophes, different sentence types and past and present progressive tense.







MATHS

As Mathematicians, we will be investigating measurements.

Length, height,, mass, capacity and temperature



As Mathematicians, we will measure centimetres and metres; compare/order length and heights and use the four operations with length and height.

As Mathematicians, we will compare mass, volume and capacity; measure grams, kilograms, millilitres and litres. We will use the four operations with mass and to solve problems with volume, capacity and temperature.

As Athletes, we will have opportunities to extend our agility, balance and co-ordination.

Key Knowledge and Skills:

Through Invasion Games, we will develop skills in Balance and Core, Travelling, Agility, Sending and Receiving. We will experience a variety of small apparatus.
